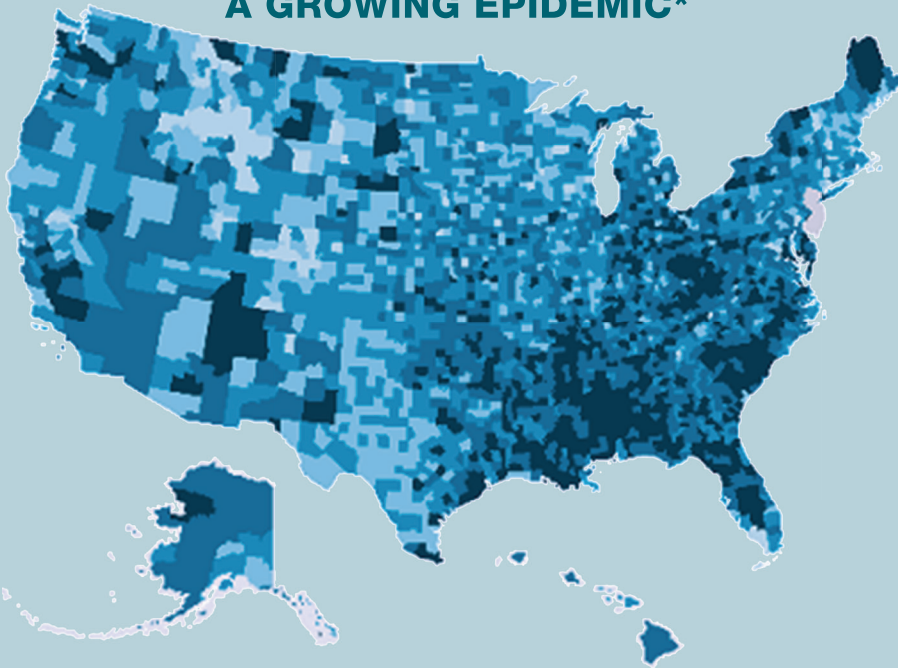


DIABETES IN AMERICA: FACTS AND FIGURES
