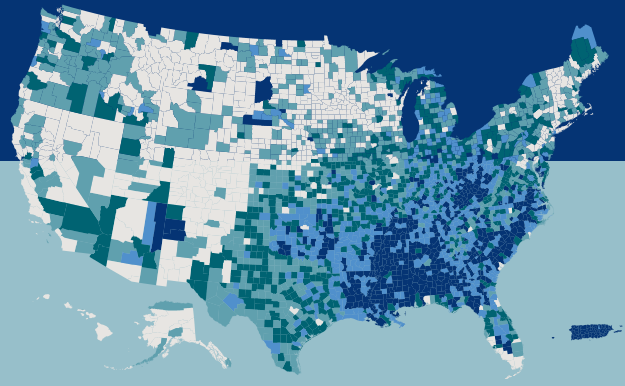


DIABETES IN AMERICA: FACTS AND FIGURES



A GROWING EPIDEMIC

34 MILLION people have diabetes



That's about **1** out of every **10** people



1 out of **4** do not know they have diabetes

88 MILLION people have prediabetes



More than **1** out of **3** adults have prediabetes



9 out of **10** do not know they have prediabetes

WITH STAGGERING COSTS



The total cost of diabetes and prediabetes in the US is **\$327 BILLION**



Risk of death for adults with diabetes is **50% HIGHER** than for adults without diabetes



Medical costs for people with diabetes are more than **TWICE** as high as for people without diabetes
