

Nomination Application Requirements

The nominator must include the following documents in the nomination package, to be submitted as a single file (preferably a PDF or Word document) in the following order:

1. Baxter Prize Nominee Questions (see below)
2. Three letters of support from the nominees' colleagues (not to exceed one page each)
3. Patents held by the nominee - List and describe any products/services for which you were awarded a patent from the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO). Indicate which type of patent was awarded, and when.
4. Nominee's CV and/or resume

Baxter Prize Nominee Questionnaire

Answers should not exceed 750 words per question.

Part I. Your Idea, Product, Service, and/or Technique

1. What was the original source of inspiration for your idea/product/service/technique?
2. What steps did you take to investigate, develop, and test your idea/product/service/technique?
3. What about your idea/product/service/technique makes it a significant (or potentially significant) and beneficial breakthrough on translating endocrine research into patient care?
4. If you receive this award, how will you use the award money to advance your idea/service/product/ technique?

Part II. Questions about Entrepreneurship

1. Babson College defines entrepreneurship as "identifying or creating an opportunity, marshaling the resources, and providing leadership to create social or economic value." How have you (and your team if applicable) embodied this definition in your work?
2. How did you prepare for your entrepreneurial journey?
3. What is the biggest mistake you made along the way?
4. What has being an entrepreneur taught you about yourself?
