EndoCares® is a global outreach initiative for patients and providers, offering medical services, wellness coaching, and education to those affected by endocrine-related conditions in underserved areas of the world. Our EndoCares® program pioneers a bold and innovative vision, ushering in the future of patient engagement. It is the hallmark of the Endocrine Society's commitment to diversity, equity, inclusion, and improved health access.

Designed for all ages, at any stage of living, our program delivers engagement with our endocrine experts, education about the latest treatments and breakthroughs in research, and psychosocial resources of living with endocrine diseases and conditions. EndoCares® brings together patients and the healthcare community in a unique and sustainable model.

Enhance access to high-quality endocrine care and wellness



Raise awareness of endocrine-related health conditions and diseases, as well as complementary treatment facilities and long-term care options for ongoing care



Empower individuals to advocate for themselves and their families by providing continued care opportunities throughout local healthcare systems



Tackle health disparities by incorporating a diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) lens to the planning and facilitation of each event, with a keen focus on addressing challenges specific to local populations

Message from Our Chief Medical Officer

While the Affordable Care Act has made health insurance more broadly available, our society still faces significant challenges in addressing health disparities. The Endocrine Society is proud to be partnering with colleagues from industry, nonprofits, and local health care providers to help address health disparities in urban areas through the EndoCares program. In 2022, EndoCares focused on diabetes, obesity, and hypertension, three diseases that disproportionately affect minority groups and the economically disadvantaged. Working with our partners, we were able to provide access to health screening, education, vaccinations, and, most importantly, follow-up medical care to hundreds of people in Atlanta, Baltimore, Phoenix, and Seattle.

In 2023, we plan to expand EndoCares to other cities, including Chicago - home of ENDO 2023. We also hope to broaden our services to include other endocrine disorders and informing participants about clinical trials that may be available in their local areas. We are grateful for the help of our partners, and most importantly to the community members and organizers who welcome us into their neighborhoods. We look forward to working with you in 2023, and beyond!

Our Impact- Atlanta

Through word of mouth and a close-knit community center, we attracted immigrants and refugees from Afghanistan, Tanzania, Congo, and other underserved parts of the world. With EndoCares® adjacent to the ENDO Annual Meeting, we leveraged the full breadth and depth of the Society's member expertise for this flagship event.

We offered a wide range of preventive interventions and educational resources, and ushered 6% of the patients to immediate follow-up care consultations. There were cholesterol screenings, hemoglobin A1c tests, and "no judgment zone" counseling services. On-site clinicians diagnosed several new cases of diabetes and hypertension — four people were treated for hypertensive crisis and two were sent to the emergency room, highlighting the immediate need for these screenings.

Our Impact- Baltimore

A wide range of community groups and dance fitness experts enhanced this city's health "charm"! Through a strong partnership with the University of Maryland and New Shiloh Baptist Church, we attracted residents from all across West Baltimore.

On-site clinicians diagnosed several new cases of diabetes and hypertension with a wide range of preventive interventions for bone density, vision, and cancer. We ushered **20%** of the patients to immediate **follow-up care** consultations.

Our Impact- Phoenix

We offered a wide range of preventive interventions and educational resources including free children's sports physicals, skin cancer, breast cancer, and financial literacy education. There were also a community group offering legal assistance consultations.

Our on-site clinicians diagnosed several new cases of diabetes, dyslipidemia and hypertension, and ushered **18%** of the patients to immediate **follow-up care** consultations.







Our Impact- Seattle

We offered a bevy of care opportunities with our partners at the University of Washington and Sea Mar Community Health Centers. On-site clinicians diagnosed several new cases of diabetes, obesity, and hypertension. We ushered **14%** of the patients to immediate **follow-up care** consultations and health insurance options.
