2. What steps did you take to investigate, develop and test your idea/product/service/technique?
3. What about your idea/product/service/technique makes it a significant (or potentially significant) and beneficial breakthrough in translating endocrine research into patient care?
4. If you receive this award, how will you use the money to advance your idea/product/service/technique?

Questions about Entrepreneurship

(Answers should not exceed 750 words per question)

1. Babson College defines entrepreneurship as "identifying or creating an opportunity, marshaling the resources, and providing leadership to create social or economic value." How have you (and your team if applicable) embodied this definition in your work?
2. How did you prepare for your entrepreneurial journey?
3. What is the biggest mistake you made along the way?
4. What has being an entrepreneur taught you about yourself?

Applicants are asked to submit three Letters of Support: Written by colleagues; not to exceed one page.
